What is your Will?

Your Will expresses your wishes for the way you want your property distributed after your death. Your Will can help to provide for loved ones, make gifts of personal possessions to friends, and make special contributions to charities.

If you don't have a Will, the State law will decide how your estate will be distributed.

Making a Will

Using a Will kit you can make your own will. However, it is advisable to talk to a solicitor about making a Will, or at the very least ask the solicitor to look over your completed Will. If your Will is unclear, your wishes may not be carried out.

When should you change your Will?

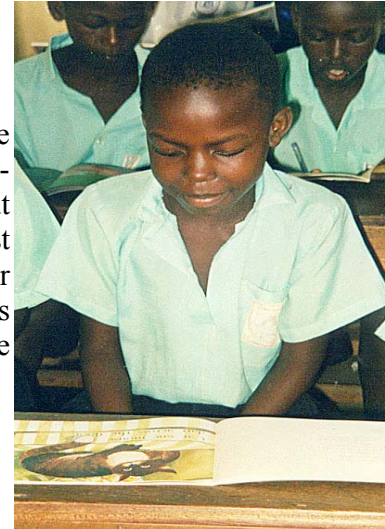
You should review your Will every ten years or so, or when your circumstances change. For example, when you get married, have children, or lose loved ones, your Will should be revised. Marriage and divorce can revoke an existing Will, so a new one becomes necessary.

Keeping your Will up to date

It is important to keep your Will up to date. You can make a new Will every time your circumstances or wishes change, or you can use a document called a codicil to make small changes for a relatively small charge.

Your Executor

It is important to choose someone you trust as the Executor of your Will. You should be sure of their ability to carry out the wishes you make in your Will. If you don't have a suitable relative or friend you can nominate, consider appointing a solicitor or trustee company as your Executor. It is advisable to appoint an alternate Executor, in case your first choice can't carry out the duties.



Leaving a Bequest

Depending on your situation, you may choose to leave a specific Bequest, or a residuary Bequest.

A specific Bequest is leaving a specified amount, or particular asset (e.g. your house, shares, jewellery) to the beneficiary. You may also choose to leave a specified percentage to a beneficiary (e.g. 50% of your estate).

After making specific Bequests, the 'residue' of your estate can be left as a residuary Bequest. You may specify one beneficiary to receive the residue, or allocate a percentage to several beneficiaries.
