To secure your place, a completed registration form, medical release form, & full payment must be received.

- Payments are non-refundable after June 24.
- Submit your information, money, & completed medical release form to the your church's youth coordinator
- Make your check payable to your church. (*Your church will send one check for the group.*)

### **CHECK-IN**

**Monday, 2:00 - 3:45 p.m.** - Plantation House Lanai

- One counselor from each church group will register their group & receive materials
- Counselor will be given all of group's tee-shirts (# & sizes determined in advance on church registration form)
- Designated counselor will share dorm keys with other church counselors for the week; keys to be returned to camp director Saturday morning after clean-up

### **THINGS TO BRING TO CAMP**

Bible, notebook, pencil or pen  
Deodorant, lotion, etc.  
Insect repellent  
Pillow  
Slippers, tennis shoes  
Money for missions offering

Beach cover up  
Sheets/blanket or sleeping bag  
Towels & washcloth  
Everyday clothes  
Pajamas

Toothbrush/toothpaste  
Soap, shampoo  
Flashlight  
Water bottle  
Swimsuit (*one-piece or two-piece  
with a dark colored t-shirt*)

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## **RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Attend counselor overview meeting on Monday afternoon following registration
- Provide proper supervision & discipline for youth from your church at all times
- Lead youth in church group devotions each evening following worship service
- Counsel young people who make decisions during worship services
  - Generally youth are paired by same gender
  - Counseling materials will be provided to help you assist youth through decision process
- Be sure youth are **present, on time, & where they belong** for all activities  
(Bible study, worship, recreation, etc.)
  - Participation in all activities is strongly encouraged for youth & counselors
- Set an example to all youth in Christian conduct & cooperation
  - Attend all your planned activities including Bible study, worship, & participate in recreation
  - Youth will become more involved if they see adults actively involved
- Under no circumstances are counselors to leave camp site without first notifying camp director
  - Only exceptions are beach excursions for swimming & Wednesday evening for dinner off-campus
- If a medical emergency occurs during camp, the counselor is to notify the camp director immediately

## **CHURCH GROUP DEVOTIONS**

- Be sure your church devotions start & end on time
- Be sensitive in observing which youth the Spirit is specifically dealing with during the week
  - Spend a little extra time with these youth & allow God to work through your ministry

## **MISCELLANEOUS**

- Due to heat & large amount of mosquitos at camp, it is advisable to bring fans, plenty of insect repellent
- If you have **military dependents** in your group, remind them ahead of time to bring their military I.D.
  - In event of an emergency where medical attention is required, they will need the I.D.

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
