SCHOLARSHIPS (*See Neighbor-Island Scholarship Form*)

Limited number of scholarships available for neighbor islanders

- **DEADLINE to request scholarships: May 27**
- Form must be completed by pastor/interim pastor, or church leader if no pastor or interim
- A maximum of five (5) scholarships will be given to church, if needed
- Church will be informed of scholarship amount granted by **June 3**

REGISTRATION

Return completed registration form, medical release forms & church check, *attention: Dawn*

- Youth & Counselors to pay their fees to their church
- Only church checks accepted for registration, payable to *Hawaii Pacific Baptist Convention*
- **FULL payment due by June 10 for \$200 rate and June 24 for \$225 rate**

Payments **NON-refundable after June 24**

HPBC can not hold "slots"

SUBSTITUTIONS

Youth & Counselors may be substituted - **SAME GENDER** - up to Thursday, July 1st

AGE

Youth Camper: Going into 7th Grade - 12th Grade Graduate

Adult Counselor: **Must be at least 19 years of age & graduated from high school at least one year**

MEDICAL RELEASE FORM

Must return completed, signed medical release form on each participant - **both youth & counselor**

- Original form included in packet - permission granted to make copies
- If participant has **no** medical insurance carrier, note on form
- Make sure family home & work phone #s, cell #, & pager #s are listed

COUNSELORS

Each church REQUIRED to send one adult for every 1-7 youth participants - SAME GENDER

- *example: 1 - 7 youth girls = 1 female counselor, 8 - 14 youth girls = 2 female counselors, etc.*
- It is the church's responsibility to enlist & secure its own counselors
- We can not accept any youth registration without a specifically named/assigned counselor - we can not hold "slots"

It is IMPERATIVE that each counselor is a Christian - Counselors will assist during invitation times in worship services and are responsible for short devotional times with their own church group

- Information sheets specifically designed for counselors enclosed - copy & distribute to each counselor

Overview meeting for all counselors on Monday afternoon after registration time

OFF-SITE MEAL

Wednesday dinner meal is optional & designed for church groups to go off campus for dinner meal

- Entire church group will either eat on campus or eat out - no split groups
- Meal will be provided for those remaining on campus (minimum of 25 people)
- This off-site meal is at your own expense & is NOT included in registration fee
- Note appropriate response on church registration form

DRESS CODE

All participants (youth & counselors) expected to reflect Christian example by their attire

- Manner of dress should be set & clearly communicated prior to coming to camp
- Modest shorts acceptable for all daytime activities & may be worn to worship services
- **Immodest shorts, tops, distasteful designs/messages, & other extreme clothing are discouraged**
- ONE-PIECE BATHING SUIT AND TWO-PIECE SUIT WITH A DARK COLORED T-SHIRT ALLOWED
- Athletic shoes/sandals/slippers

RULES & REGULATIONS

No visitors allowed during camp unless pre-arranged with camp director

- Each visitor must check in with camp director immediately upon arrival
 - an insurance fee of \$2 will be charged for daytime visitors (per visit)
- No fee for attending the evening worship services; please park at Waianae Baptist Church
