VISITORS

Visitors are welcome during evening worship services @ Waianae Baptist Church when pre-arranged with camp director by 1pm on the day of the visit. *(Minors must be accompanied by an adult.)*

RULES & REGULATIONS

Smoking or use of alcohol or non-prescription drugs is strictly prohibited

- Anyone discovered using these substances will face immediate disciplinary action &/or be sent home

Youth are allowed off campus for beach time and Wednesday evening meal only

- Anyone discovered off campus without camp director's permission will face immediate disciplinary action &/or be sent home

Each youth is expected to respect the Lord Jesus Christ in attitude, language, action & dress

- Minor infractions will be dealt with jointly by youth's church counselor & camp director
- Continuous infractions will result in youth being sent home

All participants expected to reflect Christian example by their attire

- Immodest shorts, tops, distasteful designs or messages, & other extreme clothing are strongly discouraged
